
Tutorial- Creating Weldments

Project Management (Folders)

Create / use the appropriate Inventor project (see below). Several of the parts will be modified in the tutorial. Copying the folder to the workspace will make sure everything can be modified

- 1. Copy the appropriate folder: Weldments
 - a. From: S:\TSM 216\tutorial files
 - b. To the Workspace folder
- 2. Deselect the read only option
 - a. Select the folder | Select Properties < Right Mouse Button
 - b. Deselect the Read-Only Attribute



- 3. Start Inventor
- 4. Modify the appropriate Project:
 - a. Frequently used sub-folder
 - b. Double-check: Content Center File

Note: Do not use the projects / folders described in the tutorial






